Naval Station Everett (NSE) remains committed to supporting the Navy Region Northwest Commander's Environmental Policy and operating in a responsible manner where national defense and environmental protection are compatible goals. NSE and tenant commands will comply with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements throughout the execution of the Navy mission.

For FY22, we are committed to utilizing the Environmental Management System (EMS) to achieve the following Goal and Targets:

- 1) **Goal:** Achieve compliance with EPA Stormwater permits at NSE Outfalls A, B, C and City of Everett industrial wastewater permit:
 - **Target:** Achieve EPA Permit level of 14mg/L for copper
 - **Target:** Achieve wastewater levels of 4mg/L for zinc
- 2) **Goal:** Enhance ecosystem sustainability, promote conservation, and restore and enhance habitat for fish and wildlife species:
 - **Target:** Remove or replace derelict or harmful infrastructure, such as creosote treated wood in fish-bearing waters
 - **Target:** Provide educational materials to NSE staff and visitors aimed at avoiding human disturbance of wildlife
 - **Target:** Conduct studies of fish and wildlife to inform actions to minimize species impact
- 3) **Goal:** Achieve substantial decrease in hazardous waste production through Pollution Prevention program initiatives:
 - **Target:** Reduce hazardous waste generation at shore commands by 15%
